Joinings is a book which uniquely fuses a deeply female generational story with a tingling tale of the supernatural, and stirs the heart while tickling the mind. Set in the Colorado town of Leadville, the book depicts the lives of an interlocking series of women, several of whom belong to the Sodalicium, an ancient sisterhood whose individual members are endowed with bequests or special sixth senses that enable them to tap into apparently divine powers. The book dwells principally on Lucy, a plucky castaway of sorts, orphaned early in life, who eventually washes up in the home of the only family she has a grandmother and a great aunt, thrown together late in life, and living in affectionate squabbling happiness in a small town in Colorado. Lucy s hardluck life has included her mother dying young, and her being raped and giving birth to a fatherless child, but she prevails on these kind-hearted biddies to take her and her daughter in, which they gladly do. She s always been aware of her own strangeness - a gift for divining...
