

The washed fat is then placed in a cylindrical stoneware vessel, 1 25 metres hi h and 5 metre wide, standing in a. water-bath which can be heated hy steam. A cock of wood or stoneware at the bottom of this vessel enables it to be emptied without removal from the water-bath. After the cylinder has been three-fourths filled, a kind of sieve of stoneware is laid on the surface of the fat; 10 per cent. of pure highly-diluted hydrochloric acid is added, and a well-fitting cover of stoneware is laid over the top. The dilute acid used is prepared by adding 3 lbs. pure hydrochloric acid (sp. gr. 1 12 to 100 lbs. water). On warming, as the fat melts in the cells, the acid dissolves the...
